- Life Skills teachers are suggesting that students get to do more activities
- WEB Day was successful, led by Advisors, Ms. Mendola and Ms. Parker. It's a year long mentorship for 6<sup>th</sup> grade students to bring them into the community
- o Curriculum Night was successful, and well attended
- Committee meeting (Liz and Beth) met with Principal Zawislak about activities ideas for Larson

## • Treasurer-Chris Tallman

- Reviewed budget that was arleady discussed by executive board
- At the end of last year, had an \$11,000 balance. PTO collected \$4,300 in the beginning of school. We have \$16, 526.01 balance currently
- Will need to approve the budget of \$13,405.00 for the year. Number may evolve and change this year
- o Goal of raising \$6,000 this year.
- Grants will go to supplies and items that can be used by all teachers to help enhance and positively impact the student's school experience
- o Motion to approve the budget of \$13,405.00: Kate Fellin, Second: Ms. Mendola



- VP- Kate Fellin-Mini Grants
  - Grant request of \$2700 by 19 teachers
  - Requests will be reviewed (examples, headphones for the innovation studios)
  - o Poster printer, styluses, classroom rewards for students.
  - Consider a fixed amount for classroom rewards from \$50-\$150.
  - Can approved requests up to \$150 for the first round for example then another for the next round. If that teacher has asked for a grant can apply again. Requests will be reviewed and those who are applying for the first time will be considered first
  - Grant requests will be streamlined. Teachers who are requesting the grant need to proactively research the cost and submit for the exact amount.
  - Also strongly encouraged to take a picture or description of item requested so PTO can post and share where and what their donation paid for.
  - o Teachers who are applying for the grant have to go through Christine Clifford first
